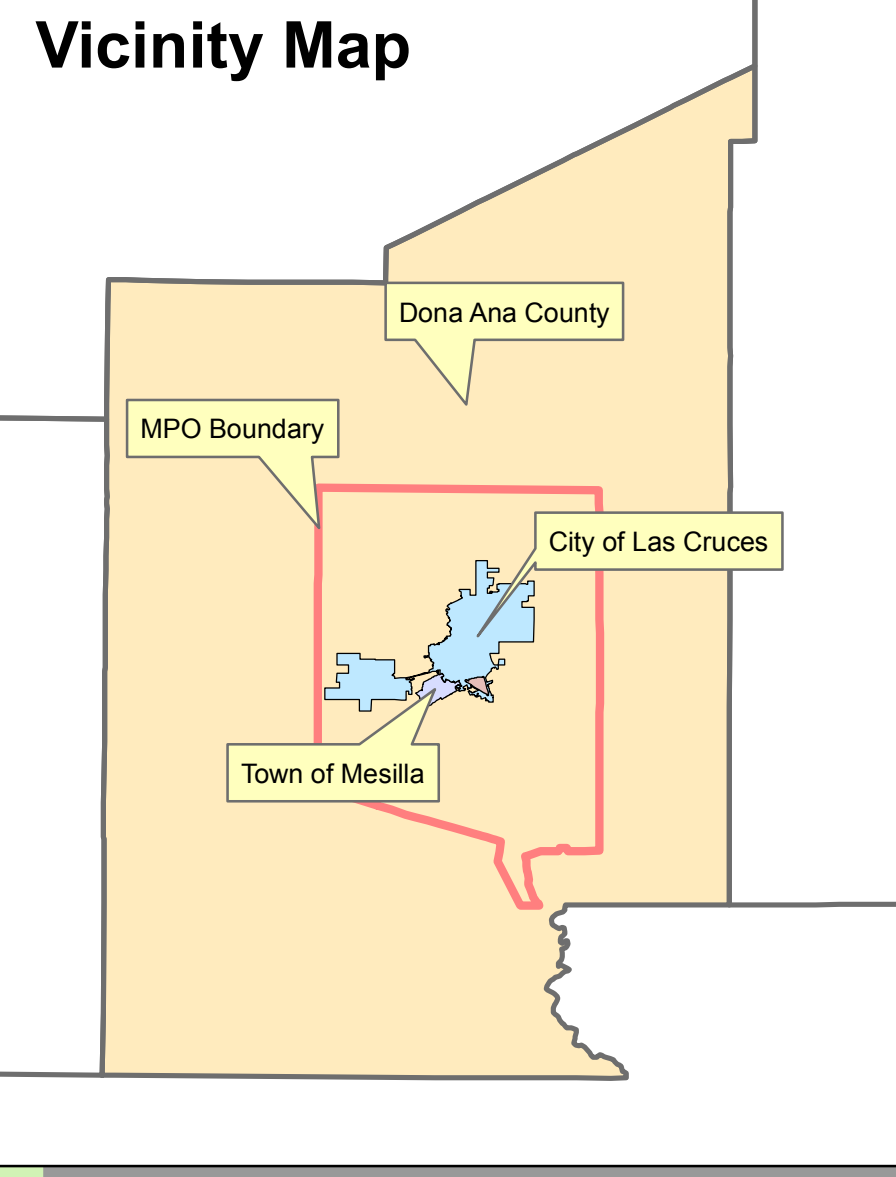
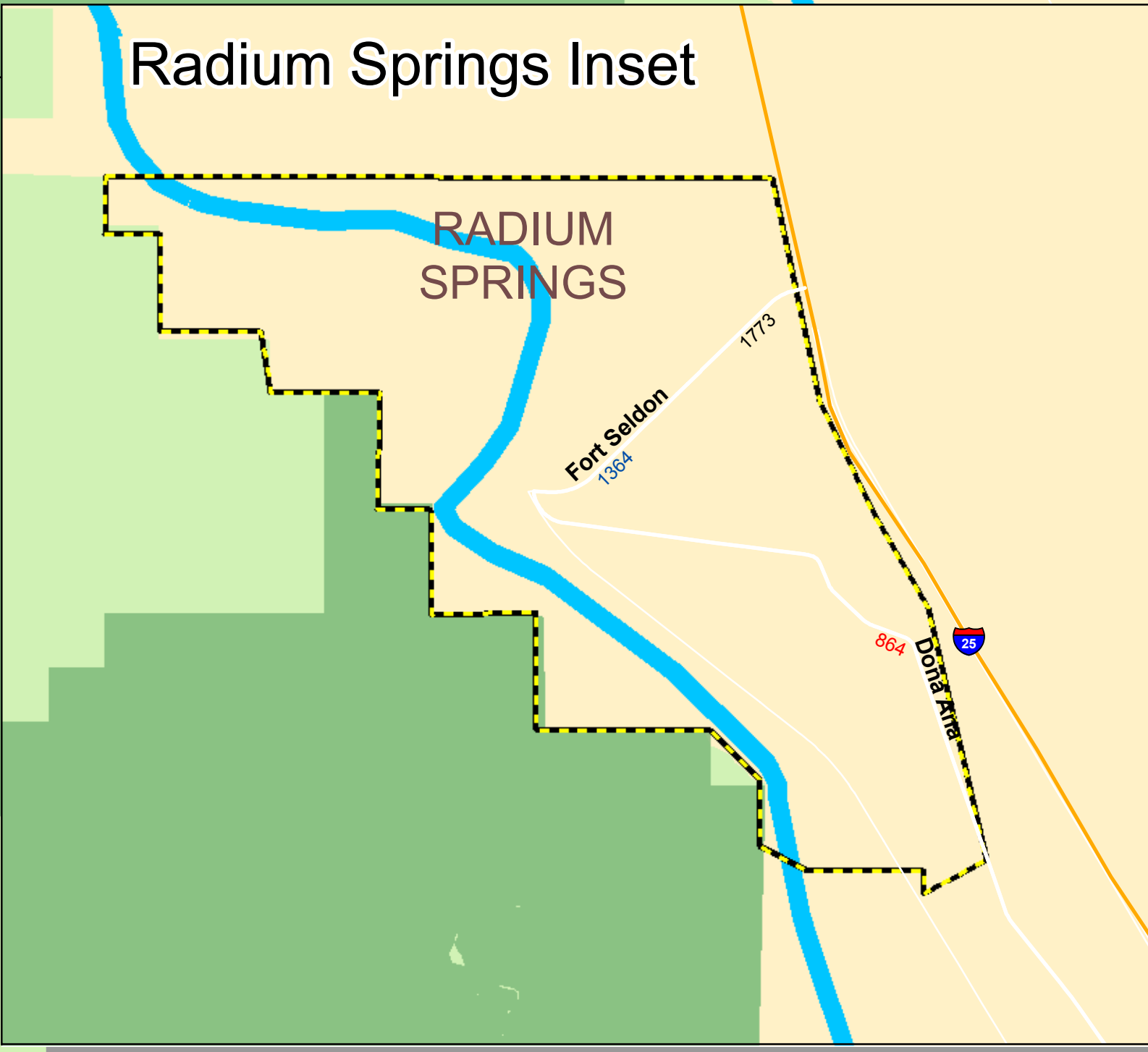




Mesilla Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization 2015 Traffic Flow Map

ANNUAL AVERAGE WEEKDAY TRAFFIC (AAWDT) OF THE LAS CRUCES URBANIZED AREA

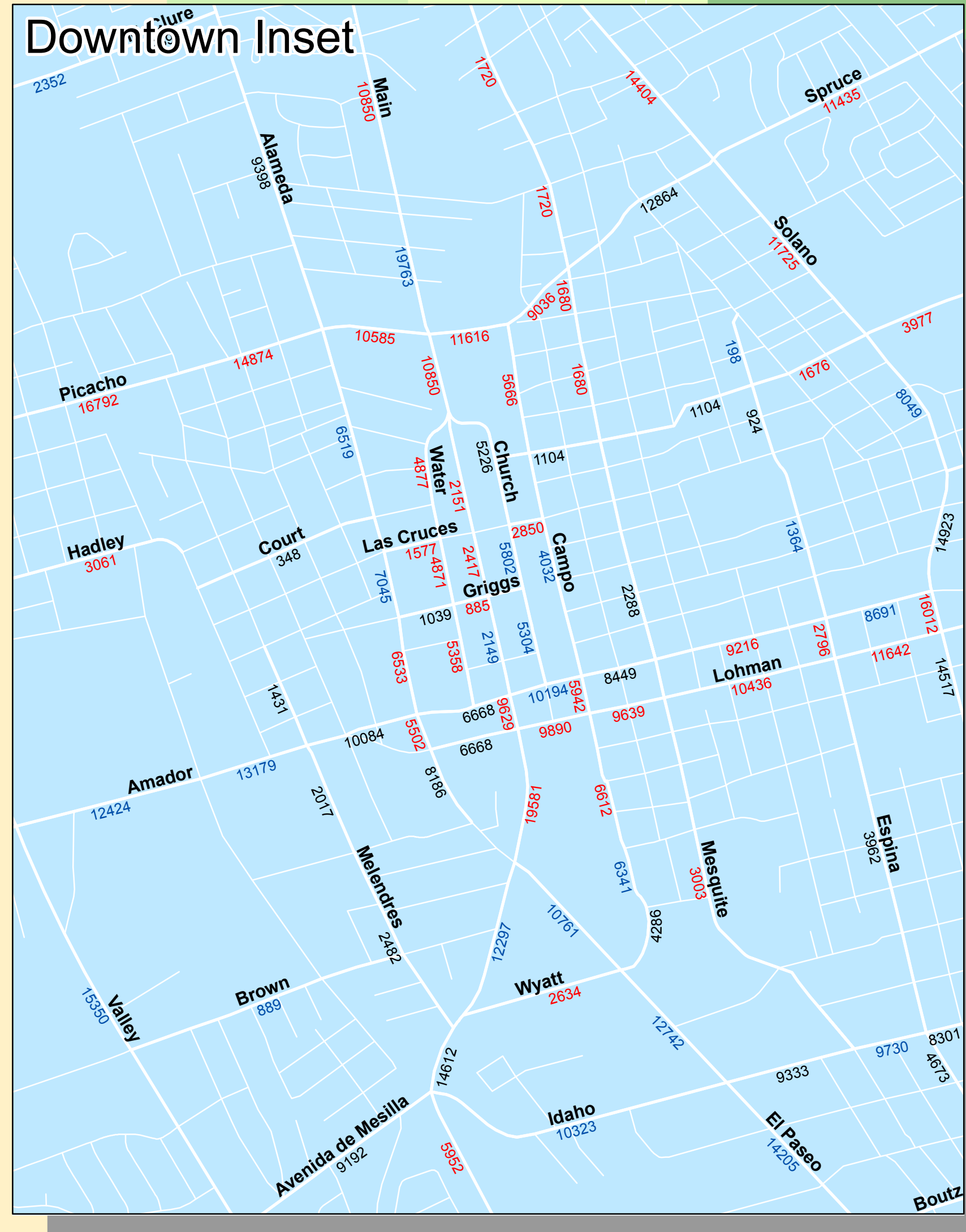
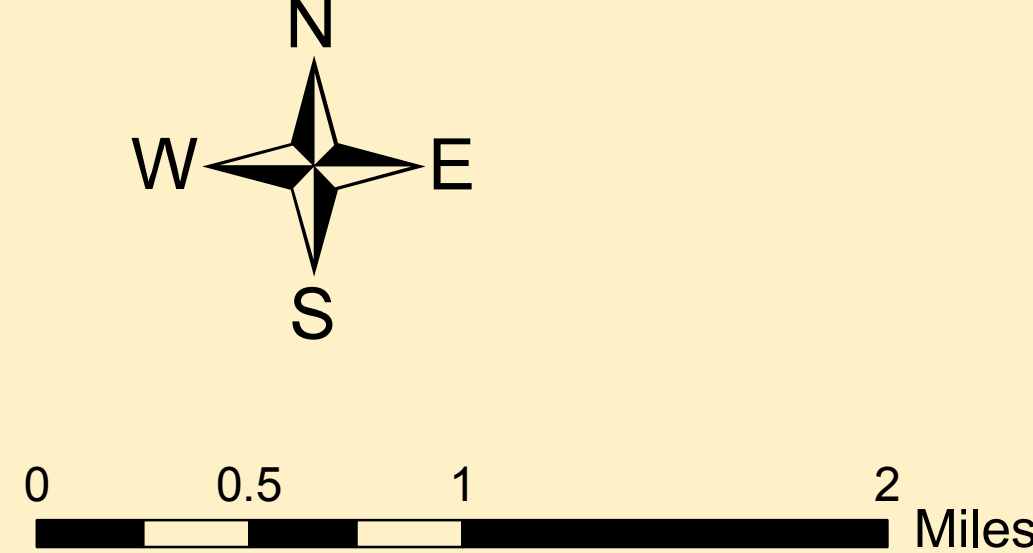
Average Annual Weekday Traffic (AAWDT) volumes are based on traffic count data accepted by the New Mexico Department of Transportation Traffic Monitoring System (TMS) as standard in accordance with the New Mexico State Traffic Monitoring Standards (NMSTMS).

2008 NMSTMS - Standard 34.0
Each year at least one-third of all traffic sections of factor groups, which are grouped by functional classification of collector or better, will be counted.

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This map is comprised of MPO thoroughfares of collector and above and a sampling of local roads. This map is for AAWDT volume purposes only and is not intended to be used as a road map.
