MESILLA VALLEY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION RESOLUTION NO. 21-04

A RESOLUTION AMENDING MOBILITY 2045 TO INCORPORATE THE ROADRUNNER TRANSIT SAFETY TARGETS

The Mesilla Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Policy Committee is Informed that:

WHEREAS, the Mesilla Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization is the transportation planning agency for the City of Las Cruces, the Town of Mesilla, and the urbanized area of central Doña Ana County; and

WHEREAS, 23 CFR § 450.322 requires that all MPO's throughout the country adopt a minimum 20-year Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) for their respective jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the MPO adopted *Mobility 2045*, its Metropolitan Transportation Plan for 2020 on July 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, 49 CFR § 673.15 (a) & (b) requires that transit agencies must coordinate with Metropolitan Planning Organizations in their Safety Performance Targets; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico Department of Transportation Transit and Rail Division, in their oversight role of the transit funding at Mesilla Valley MPO, require that the RoadRUNNER Transit Safety Performance Targets be adopted into the MTP for future planning purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities Advisory Committee recommended approval of this amendment at their February 16, 2021 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Technical Advisory Committee recommended approval of this amendment at their March 4, 2021 meeting; and

WHEREAS, the Policy Committee has determined that it is in the best interest of the MPO for the Mesilla Valley MPO to amend *Mobility 2045* to include the RoadRUNNER Transit Safety Targets.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Policy Committee of the Mesilla Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization:

THAT the Mesilla Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization adopts the RoadRUNNER Transit Safety Performance Targets, as contained in Exhibit "A", which are attached hereto and made part of this resolution.

THAT the information contained in Exhibit "A" be included as part of Appendix A in Mobility 2045.
