**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE CALLS FOR PROJECT  
PROCESS FOR THE MESILLA VALLEY MPO**

The Mesilla Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Policy Board is informed that:

**WHEREAS**, NMDOT Planning has informed the Mesilla Valley MPO staff of an increase in Federal and State Call for projects, and

**WHEREAS**, NMDOT District One has informed Mesilla Valley MPO staff that all call for projects applications going forward will have to be prioritized by the Mesilla Valley MPO; and

**WHEREAS**, In response to this, Mesilla Valley MPO Staff has put together a Standard Operating Procedure for Call for Projects; and

**WHEREAS**, Per the Standard Operating Procedure, The Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities Advisory Committee (BPAC) will offer a recommendation of call for project application rankings; and

**WHEREAS**, Per the Standard Operating Procedure, The Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) will offer a recommendation of the call for project application rankings; and

**WHEREAS**, Per the Standard Operating Procedure, The Policy Board will rank all call for project applications; and

**WHEREAS**, The Policy Board is the final authority for the Mesilla Valley MPO in ranking all project applications for calls for projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the Policy Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the MPO for the Resolution establishing a Call for Projects Process be APPROVED.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Policy Committee of the Mesilla Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization:


**THAT** the Call for Projects Standard Operating Procedure as shown in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and made part of this resolution.
